IS.Statistics Derivatives enables issuers to analyse derivative sales by several criteria day by day to refine their product strategy based on actual market evidence. IS.OptionsAnalyser is a Java application that presents exchange-traded options with different strike prices and various maturities in a matrix. Financial advisors can use it to optimise investment strategies by simulating the effect of changes in option price, underlying price and

implied volatility on the option and its key figures. IS.Derivatives ScenarioScreener allows retail banks and online brokers the easy selection of certificates that match market scenarios and the investor's risk preference, based on complex mathematical calculations.
